

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
FOR
ON-CALL ROOF REPAIR SERVICES**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”) and Best Contracting Services, Inc., with a place of business at 19027 S. Hamilton Ave., Gardena, CA 90248 (“Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract MA-080-19011627 for On-Call Roof Repair Services, effective April 29, 2019 through April 28, 2022, in the Total Contract Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$75,000.00 per year, (“Contract”); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to renew the Contract for two (2) years effective April 29, 2022 through April 28, 2024, with a new Total Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$75,000.00 per year; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to update title of Attachment A in the attachments list; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

1. Article 2 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

Contract shall be renewed for two (2) years starting April 29, 2022, unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.

* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signator to bind the corporation.
